



Class Rescheduling Option

The Regina Music Festival Association is introducing a pilot program aimed at trying to support participants who are unable to perform at their scheduled date and time as published in the Festival 2019 Program. The Board of Directors will review the pilot program to determine whether to continue with this option.

Please note that this project is intended only for those who have a serious conflict with their scheduled class but wish to be able to perform and receive feedback from the adjudicator. Any rescheduled performances will be for adjudication only. No marks will be given and therefore the participant should understand that the performance will not be eligible for scholarship consideration nor for advancement to the Provincial Festival.

- Participants who are unable to attend their scheduled class as published in the Festival 2019 Program can make a request to be rescheduled with the following limitations:
 - Requests must be made by the participant (or parent/guardian) by email to info@reginamusicfestival.org.
 - The written request should contain the participant's name, the class number as well as the date and time of the class. Please also indicate that this document has been read carefully.
 - Once the request is made, the original scheduled time will be forfeited.
 - Requests must be made by April 1st for Musical Theatre, Pipe Organ and Choral and by April 15th for all other disciplines. **Last minute cancellations cannot be rescheduled.**
 - The Festival will attempt to find an opening created by other cancellations but does not commit to being able to do so.
 - Adjudicators will not be asked to begin early or end late AND scheduled classes will not be shortened.
 - A maximum of two (2) alternative times will be offered.
 - These spots will be offered on a *first come, first serve* basis.
- Once a new time has been agreed upon, the participant will be responsible for notifying their teacher.
- If the performance includes an accompanist, confirmation of the accompanist's availability will be required.
- In the case of a small ensemble, each member of the ensemble will be required to confirm their availability.
- The rescheduled performance will be for ADJUDICATION ONLY. It will not count towards scholarships or provincial recommendations and may affect eligibility for other scholarships and provincial recommendations*.
